Position Summary

The Department of Clinical Sciences at Colorado State University seeks applications for a 12-month tenure-track Assistant or Associate Professor in Equine Theriogenology. This position will be housed at the Equine Reproduction Laboratory located on the Foothills Campus of Colorado State University. The Equine Reproduction Laboratory (ERL) at Colorado State University has a long and storied history in the field of horse reproduction. The cornerstones of the program have always been dedicated basic and applied research, outstanding education for undergraduate, graduate and veterinary students, world class continuing education courses, and superior clinical service. We are looking for an exceptional individual that understands the value of tradition, is willing to collaborate and contribute to our existing program, and can provide a vision and leadership for the future. The Equine Reproduction Laboratory has high-quality facilities, a strong clinical case load, and a great support team.

Qualifications

- DVM or equivalent veterinary professional degree.
- Diplomate status in the American College of Theriogenologists (ACT) is required.
- An advanced graduate degree or equivalent research experience is desirable.
- Experience instructing veterinary students and residents in the reproductive management of horses is desirable.

Specific Responsibilities

Teaching

- **Clinical:** Provide clinical instruction in equine theriogenology to residents, third and fourth year veterinary students, and other students at the Equine Reproduction Laboratory (ERL) and/or the Veterinary Teaching Hospital (VTH).
- **Didactic:** Provide lecture and laboratory instruction for veterinary students on topics related to general or equine theriogenology. Active participation in lectures and laboratory activities in the Foaling Management course is also expected. Participation in graduate level courses is also encouraged.
- **Graduate Training:** Participate in the advising, mentoring, and instruction of Equine Theriogenology residents and other graduate students within a program involving the area of the successful candidate's research interests and expertise.

Research

- Develop an independent and/or collaborative research program in the discipline of equine theriogenology

- Develop and obtain internal and external funding to support an active research program.

Service and Outreach

- **Clinical Service:** Provide 26 weeks of clinical activity in the Mare and Stallion Services at the Equine Reproduction Laboratory. Provide Equine Theriogenology clinical support at the Veterinary Teaching Hospital throughout the year. Clinical responsibility will include every-other-weekend active duty at the ERL and rotate on night emergency duty (foaling, dystocia, etc.) and evening/night mare evaluations for breeding with frozen stallion semen.
- **Outreach:** Provide phone and/or email consultation for veterinarians in Colorado and other states. Develop and participate in continuing education programs for veterinarians and horse owners, both at Colorado State University and other locations.
- **Administrative:** Participate in Departmental, College, and University administrative committees as well as active participation in the organization and implementation of the goals for the Equine Reproduction Laboratory and the Equine Section of the Veterinary Teaching Hospital.

Salary, rank and start-up packages will be competitive and commensurate with the qualifications of the applicant.
